Personal Titles and Abbreviations

- Senator, Secretary of State, Mayor, etc.
- □ President, Prime Minister, King, Queen, etc.
- □ Capt., Lt., P.F.C., etc
- Only capitalize these titles if they come directly in front of a specific name.
 - The senator from New York is Clinton.
 - New York's Senator Clinton was running for president.

Family Relationships

- Capitalize family words only if they are used as names or before names.
- Mother
 - My mother is a saint.
 - That is Mother; she is a saint.
- Cousin
 - My favorite cousin is Marsha.
 - I am going with Cousin Marsha to the movies.

The Pronoun I

- She and I are best friends.
- When will I receive my money?

Quotations

- Capitalize the first word of a direct quote if it is a complete sentence.
 - Ms. Berger said, "My favorite class is English."
- If the quote is divided do not capitalize the second portion of the quote (unless it starts a new sentence.)
 - "My favorite class," said Ms. Berger, "is English."
 - "My favorite class is English," said Ms. Berger, "It is fabulous!"
