Call for Scholarship Proposals

The Check Point Founded Institute for Information Security (CPIIS) is soliciting proposals for funding graduate students and post-doctoral fellows that perform research in all aspects of information and computer security. Research topics include (but not limited to):

- Data, System and Network Security
- Hardware and embedded systems security
- Security modeling and analysis
- Privacy of personal data in public databases
- Cryptography and cryptographic protocols
- Human interaction and usability aspects of information security
- Economics of Information Security

The call is open to individuals who will be graduate students or post-doctoral fellows within Tel Aviv University during the 2009/2010 academic year. The funding will be for one year, starting September 2009 with potential extension. Proposals for funding should contain:

- A one to two page description of the proposed research and its relevance.
- CV of the proposed beneficiary.
- Support letter by advisor or host at Tel Aviv University
- Additional supporting material, such as letters of reference, is optional.

Decisions will be announced no later than July 15, 2009.
